

- Setting
 - Written to the Church at Ephesus
 - Deep Relationship
 - Paul 2nd Missionary Journey Acts 18
 - Amazing work of God Acts 19:11-12
- "And God was doing extraordinary miracles by the hands of Paul, ¹² so that even handkerchiefs or aprons that had touched his skin were carried away to the sick, and their diseases left them and the evil spirits came out of them."

- close relationship Acts 20 Paul writing from Jail
- 1. We Are
 - chosen by God 1:4
 - adopted as children 1:5
 - Redeemed 1:7
 - Forgiven 1:7
 - Given an Inheritance 1:11
 - Sealed with Holy Spirit 1:13

Paul Prays for Them 1:15-22

- hearing of their faith in Lord & love for one another
- Receive:
 - spirit of wisdom
 - revelation of the knowledge of Christ
 - eyes of their hearts enlightened

- 2. Recall the Reality
 - a) We Were
 - Dead in trespass & sin
 - Sabotaged by Satan
 - Sentenced for our Situation

But God "4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—6 and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus,"

- motivated by love and mercy
- made us alive in Christ
- made us visible recipients
 - immeasurable kindness, grace
- made us to be participants
- Eph 2:8-10 "For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, 9 not a result of works, so that no one may boast. ¹⁰ For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them"

- b) One in Christ 2:11-22
 - Old Reality as Gentiles we....
 - separated, alienated, strangers, without hope
 - Jesus Reconciled Us
 - dividing wall torn down, peace with God and others, equal access to Father
 - New Reality family
 - fellow citizens, very dwelling place of God

- 3. No Longer a Mystery 3:1-13
 - clear to all, through Jesus
 - fellow heirs, members of one body, partakers in the promises of God
- we are to be a witness visible in heavens and on earth
 - Paul Prays that God would
 - strengthen the inner man
 - rooted and grounded in love
 - strengthened to comprehend

4. Walk in a Manner Worthy

"I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, ² with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, ³ eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. ⁴ There is one body and one Spirit just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call— 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism, ⁶ one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."

- a) Call to Christian Unity
 - posture matters humility, gentleness, patience, bearing with one another, eager to maintain.
- b) Recognize the Gifts and Plan of God 4:7-16
 - every believer has a spiritual gift
 - God decides what gift he gives
 - Distinct roles to the gifts
 - equip for works of service
 - ministry to the body of Christ

- when using the gifts
 - speak the truth in love
 - connected and joined together
- c) Embracing New Life in Christ
 - no longer walk as Gentiles do
 - darkened understanding, alienated from the life of God, ignorant of Christ, hard hearts, callous, greedy to practice impurity

- Put off the Old Self
- Put on New Self 4:20-25

"But that is not the way you learned Christ!— ²¹ assuming that you have heard about him and were taught in him, as the truth is in Jesus, 22 to put off your old self, which belongs to your former manner of life and is corrupt through deceitful desires, 23 and to be renewed in the spirit of your minds, ²⁴ and to put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness."

- change your clothes
 - off with falsehood, sinful anger, theft, corrupt talk
 - on with truth, meekness, honest work, generosity, building up, blessing
- put off bitterness, wrath, slander, malice
- put on kindness, tender hearted, forgiving
- ³² Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.

So What

- 1. Remember Reality
- once dead in sin, separated from God, without hope
- we are chosen, redeemed, forgiven, sealed, given and inheritance
- 2. One Family
 - all come to relationship with God the same way
- reconciled through Christ able to have peace with God and one another

So What

- 3. God has a plan and role for us
 - to be visible and evident
 - gifted, empowered, participants with God
- 4. Given who we are walk in a manner worthy
 - embrace new life in the family
 - put off
 - put on
- 5. Ask God to reveal to you, read Ephesians
